Since its beginning in 1964, the Center for Science and Mathematics Education (CSME) at Southern Miss has conferred over 195 doctoral degrees and over 1,250 master's degrees to students in science or mathematics education. CSME graduates are tenured research professors in STEM departments, colleges of education, community colleges, state departments of education and school districts.

The Center currently serves **37 graduate students** in CSME programs. We also teach preservice STEM teachers and offer environmental science for over **500 students annually**.

CSME helps students explore, measure and quantify the ways people of all ages think and learn STEM content through our rigorous coursework that blends educational research, design and theory with graduate-level science and mathematics content, research and field experiences, and our ongoing STEMed Speaker Series, featuring STEM education researchers from around the world.

The Master of Science (M.S.) program prepares educators to develop and analyze educational research, curriculum materials and educational activities with an emphasis in formal or informal settings. The Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) program prepares educators, researchers and university faculty in mathematics or science education, culminating in a dissertation project.
